_____ **Catechist (Teacher)** – teaches class lesson. A teacher’s manual is provided along with lesson plan help. Classes are limited to 15-20 students per class and an aide is present in every class. Past teaching experience is not required; only a desire to spread the word of God and a love of children. Training will be provided. A weekly commitment is necessary.

_____ **Aide** – work with Catechist handing out papers and pencils, taking attendance, learning prayers, helping with classroom management, and filling in for Catechist for one night, if necessary. A weekly commitment is necessary.

_____ **Substitute Catechist/Aide** – available on short notice to teach lesson prepared by class catechist or to fill in as an Aide.

_____ **Teenage Aide** – helps the Catechist and Aide during class. This ministry is a great idea for a Senior Project. A weekly commitment is necessary.

_____ **Crossing Guard** – helps students cross the street before and after class. Times needed at school are 6:10-6:35 and 7:25-7:50. Depending on the number of people who volunteer for this ministry, may only need a commitment of 5-6x a year.

_____ **Tutor** – works in separate classroom with a child, one on one.

_____ **Hall Monitor** – makes sure children are not alone in the hallway and order is maintained. Collects any important papers from Catechists for the Office. Depending on the number of people who volunteer for this ministry, may only need a commitment of 5-6x a year.

_____ **Church Monitor** – helps maintain order in the Church as the 4th-6th grade students arrive. Times needed are 6:00-6:30. Depending on the number of people who volunteer for this ministry, may only need a commitment of 5-6x a year.

_____ **Child Care Monitor** – helps watch children (ages 3-5) of Catechists and Aides during class time. Materials and activities will be provided. Depending on the number of people who volunteer for this ministry, may only need a commitment of once a month.
